Privacy & Data Management Policy

Under new laws, effective from May 2018, we need to provide you with certain details concerning how your personal data will be used and protected.

The Elizabeth Coteman Fund takes the protection of the data we hold about you extremely seriously and we are committed to respecting your confidentiality and privacy. This policy explains how we collect and use personal information we collect, how we comply with the law on data protection, and what your rights are.

Personal data collected by us is for the sole purpose of helping to deliver our stated, and constitutional, aims and objectives – <u>read our constitution</u>.

Data is never collected, held or shared about you, by us, without your express permission.

Who we will disclose your personal data to	 NHS staff involved in your care Other charities involved in your care/support Volunteers (attached to The Elizabeth Coteman Fund) who may be working with you on our behalf NB – your personal data will not be shared with a third party without your prior knowledge and permission, unless we are required by law to release it.
Legal basis for processing your personal data	 The legal basis for the collection/processing of your personal data is: For legitimate and relevant administration, governance and programme delivery purposes relating to our stated aims and objectives
Your right to withdraw consent	Where you have given your consent to any processing of personal data, you have the right to withdraw that consent at any time. If you do, it will not affect the lawfulness of any processing for which we had your consent prior to your withdrawing it.
Location of your personal data	The Elizabeth Coteman Fund will keep your personal data within the European Economic Area.
How long we will keep your personal data for	We will not retain your personal data for longer than is reasonable and necessary for the purposes for which it was collected. We shall retain your personal data for such time as you or a family member is receiving support from, or associated with, The Elizabeth Coteman Fund.
Your rights in respect of your personal data	You have the right of access to your personal data and, in some cases, to require us to restrict, erase or rectify it or to object to our processing it, and the right of data portability. Depending on the amount of work involved a fee may be payable if you request details of personal information held about you.
